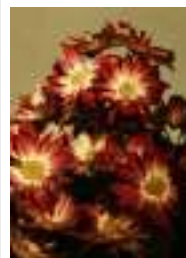
Enjoy the Fall leaves as we travel to Grady, Alabama. The school was built in 1910 and the restaurant opened in 1985.
